This year's tournament will feature fourteen (14) men's teams and seven (7) women's teams.

I have attached the pools for men's and women's basketball. I have also attached the tournament brackets we expect to follow. Seeding will be done at the conclusion of the pool play games.

#### Information:

1. A sports trainer will be on-site and will have emergency medical equipment, however, each team is expected to provide their own tape, ice packs, band-aids, etc.
2. The first team in the pool will be the home team. The top team on the bracket will be the home team. Home team will wear white.
3. Shot clocks will not be used in Goodell Gymnasium, but, they will be used at Douglas.
4. The first two days, games will be played on two courts in Goodell Gymnasium on the campus of SDSM&T. Teams and fans can park anywhere around the King Center where you will not be ticketed. If you park anywhere else on the campus, you may be ticketed.
