All applicants must complete the admissions process and be admitted as a student at the Oglala Lakota College (Admissions Policy #80-000)

The CARF program participants may be supported by a scholarship. Students that elect to participate in the CARF program cannot receive PELL as these courses are preparatory only. CARF students are not considered full time students and the courses are non-transferable.

Furthermore, students must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the scholarship support of \$300 per course level advancement at the end of the fall/spring program.

1. Students must complete the course(s) they elect to take
2. Students must adhere to the OLC attendance Policy. Three consecutive absences or five scattered absences will result in the students being ineligible for the scholarship
3. Students entering at the O83A level must advance to the O83B level at the end of the 15 week fall or spring sessions. Students must meet a minimum of 45 documented contact hours before final testing on the College Readiness Assessment (Accuplacer).
4. Students entering in at the O83B level must advance to the O93 level at the end of the 15 week fall or spring sessions. Students must meet a minimum of 45 documented contact hours before final testing on the College Readiness Assessment (Accuplacer).

However, testing into the O83 level I understand I will not be able to be officially enrolled until I pass into the RW093 level.
