Required Criteria:

Stage One: Entry Level Major

The student signs up for the program when they enter OLC or when they decide on a major. All initial majors are accepted.

Stage Two: Advanced Major

The student must apply for advanced major status during the semester they take:
SoSc 233 Social Science Research

The student will need to submit:

1. A completed degree application
2. Unofficial transcripts
3. An autobiographical sketch

The student is admitted to the program if they meet the requirements:

- a) 2.0 GPA
- b) Verification of course completion (should have successfully completed Engl 103, Engl 113, SpCm 103, and SoSc 103 and five (5) other General or Lakota Studies Core courses.)
- c) Competency in writing skills as determined by the Leadership and Communication program entry rubric.

Students who do not meet requirements, will be able to reapply after improving their GPA, after completing required courses, or after building writing skills.
