

Graduation Requirement Course Form

OGLALA LAKOTA COLLEGE

The purpose of a Graduation Requirement Course is to assist the student with continued persistence and timely completion of their degree. Graduation Requirement Courses are intended for degree seeking students only. Non degree seeking students or students in special programs do not qualify for a GRC. Not all courses can be taught through this mode of delivery. All Courses suitable for a GRC are designated by the Department Chair and Approved by the Vice President for Instruction and Registrar. All Graduation Requirement Course (GRC) requests must be approved by the Department Chairperson and the Vice President of Instruction.

A GRC will not be allowed if the same course is offered within fifty (50) miles of the student's home district or online. However, if there is a scheduling conflict, a student may still apply. Students are allowed two graduation requirement courses per semester.

Students who successfully complete 45 hours towards their first AA/AAS or 96 hours towards their first Bachelor's degree are eligible to apply for a GRC.

Students must have an overall Grade Point Average of at least 2.75 and be in good standing, or 3.00 for the previous 24 credit hours, verified by the Registrar's Office.

All disapproved GRC's will be sent back to the student's home center.
