OLC Multi-purpose Building

1. If you are a K-12 Institution on the Pine Ridge Reservation, you may enter 25 projects. The **suggested** breakdown is

5 projects for grades K-5

5 projects for grades 6-8

10 projects for grades 9-12

2. If you are a K-8 institution, you may enter a total of 15 projects.

3. Rules #1 and #2 may be invalid if the total number of entrants warrants invalidity. Call Misty Brave after April 13, 2018 at 455-6002 or 685-4098 to see if there is space available for extra projects.

4. Projects must be free standing and not more than 30 inches deep (76 cm), 48 inches wide (122 cm), and 78 inches (198 cm) from the tabletop.

5. If you need an electrical outlet or a computer, please contact Misty Brave at 455-6002 or 685-4098. You must supply the electrical cords and computer.

6. The following are all **PROHIBITED:**

Open dissections – use pictures

Dried plants – use pictures

Dangerous chemicals

Open flames

Explosives

Animal experiments that involve starvation or any other sort of cruelty

Live animals

Live plants

Glass containers

OLC reserves the right to disallow any science project that does not meet science fair regulations.

8. All entrants must submit a display and an entry form. Entry forms must be returned to Misty Brave by **5:00 PM April 13, 2018** via mail, e-mail or FAX (605) 455-2603.

10. Grades K-3 students may enter as a class.

11. Grades 4-12 must enter as a small group of 2-4 students OR they may enter as individuals.
